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## **Prerequistes to Attend the Bootcamp**

  - **Important Note:** Previous bootcamp alumni encourage using your own iPad for adapting and creating your content. If you do not have an iPad that works with an Apple Pencil, Apple will supply you with one during the bootcamp.

  - Support faculty member's digital innovation idea/project
  - Support potential training and/or presentation of knowledge and tools gained at the bootcamp to fellow faculty members within your nursing program
