- The Novice Faculty Excellence in Didactic Teaching Award
- The Novice Faculty Excellence in Clinical Teaching Award
- Excellence and Innovation in Teaching Award
- Advancement of Teaching and Learning Scholarship Award

The two novice awards focus on faculty with five years or less teaching experience. *The Excellence and Innovation in Teaching Award* focuses on exemplary teaching practices, while the *Advancement of Teaching and Learning Scholarship Award* recognizes sustained and systematic inquiry into the practice of teaching and the environment and depth of student learning.
