

Report of the Interprofessional Education Collaborative (IPEC) March 2015

To date, IPEC has hosted 7 faculty development institutes, with two more planned for Spring and Fall of 2015. For the first time, the Spring 2015 Institute will be focused on Population Health with several teams bringing a community-based partner. Programming is anchored in the ***Core Competencies for Interprofessional Collaborative Practice*** released by IPEC in May 2011. The institutes provide faculty from across the health professions with the opportunity to meet with peers in plenary and interactive sessions focused on building strong programs for team-based learning. The goal of the institutes is to have each faculty team create a tangible product, which is an implementation plan for interprofessional education at their institution. The IPEC principals, planning committee, and communication committee, from the six founding organizations, work together to create these cutting-edge programs. Moving forward, there will be two institutes per year, one focused on basic interprofessional education and one focused on a specific topic. Below are data related to the seven institutes:

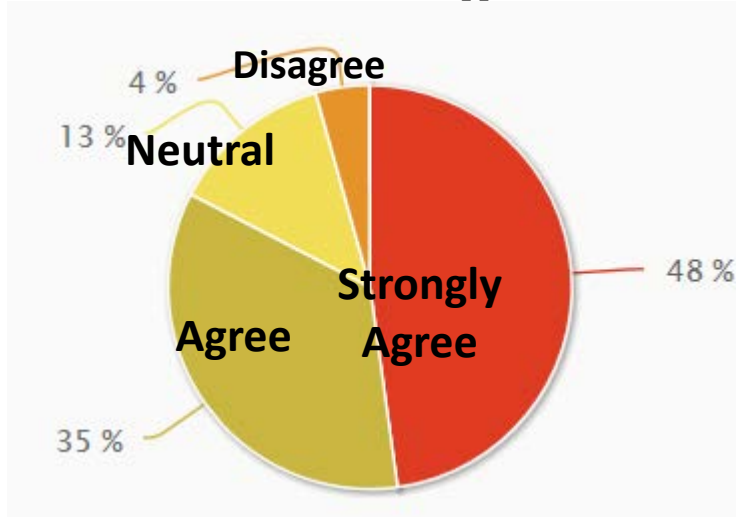

Overall: The October 2014 institute was applicable to our team’s needs.



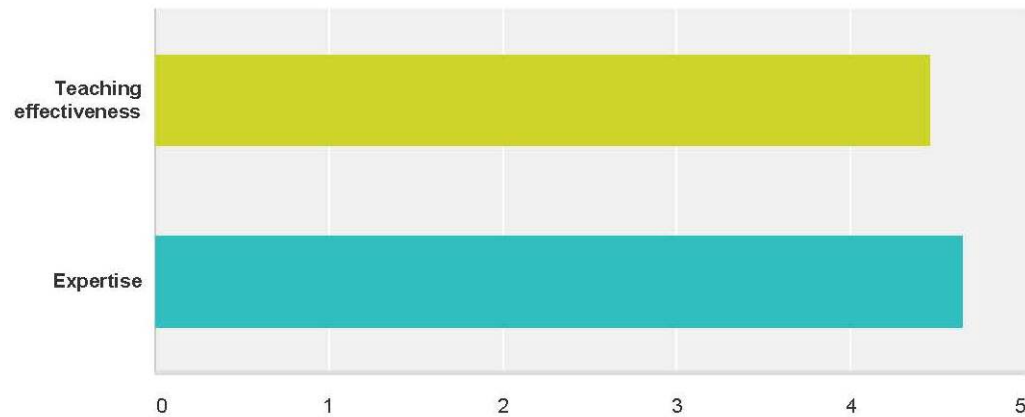
Spring 2015 Institute

Currently, there are 35 teams of 155 attendees registered for the upcoming April 29-May 1, 2015 Institute to be held in Herndon, VA. Ten teams have included a community-based partner (e.g. state or local public health department, clinic, social services agency, hospital, health center, payer, etc.) as a part of their team composition. Additionally, 25 registered teams are repeat attendees who have previously attended at least one IPEC institute. Many teams have indicated a high level of IPE experience with 22 teams stating to have had “some success with IPE.”

IPEC Webinars

On December 9, 2014, IPEC hosted a webinar for AACN’s Graduate Student Nursing Academy (GNSA). The webinar was focused on the history and formation of IPEC and on the impact of IPE on future health outcomes. The webinar presenters were the six IPEC leaders from the founding organizations. A total of 333 members registered to attend the webinar with 185 individuals logging in on the day of the event. Additionally, 88 individuals completed the evaluation survey.
