

At its meeting on January 18-20, 2022, the CCNE Board of Commissioners directed the following programs to "show cause" as to why adverse action should not be taken against the program. Importantly, the issuance of a show cause directive is not an adverse action, but a statement of serious concern by the Board. In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations, \$602.26(b), CCNE is required to notify various entities, including the U.S. Department of Education, of this action.
