- 1 in 2 babies does not have enough diapers to keep them clean, dry, and healthy
- Safety net programs like WIC or food stamps do not cover diapers
- A healthy supply of diapers costs \$80–120 per child, per month
- Many parents have to choose between buying food or diapers
