

PhD in Nursing: A BSN to PhD or 3-Year Accelerated Model to the Research Doctorate

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Do we need more nurses with a research doctorate?

- Impending shortage of nursing faculty
 - Shortage may be ameliorated by increasing number of new DNPs
- The needs remains for PhD prepared nurses to teach, do research, and serve as academic leaders



Shortage of PhD Prepared Nurses is not Improving


Only 1% of nurses hold research doctorate

Nurses enter PhD study later in life

Nurses have fewer years to teach, develop research programs, and advance through the ranks to become academic leaders



3 Increased funding for full-time study



Established Benchmarks for Progression







Enhanced intensive mentoring



- Formally trained mentors
- Guidance on students' career trajectories
 - Networking
- Frequent meetings with students
 - Students are immersed early into mentor's research team
- Opportunities for students to publish

Early integration of promising undergraduates

- Research participation
- Research Faculty interaction
- Inclusion into PhD events
 - Poster Sessions
 - Talks

Limitations

- Short time frame
 - Few students
