Diversity, Equity, Inclusion in the Nursing Curriculum at Cape Cod Community College

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
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
Purpose

- ➤ Cape Cod Community College Nursing program recognizes the importance of a relevant curriculum.
- Nursing curriculum needs to adapt and incorporate tools to help nursing students.
- ➤ Incorporating Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) in the nursing curriculum is the key to prepare educated DEI nurses for the future. This was as an identified need in the Cape Cod & Islands region of Massachusetts.

Background

- ➤ Over 80% of RNs in MA are white non-Hispanic, making the nursing workforce considerably less diverse than the state population.
- Increased numbers of students from diverse backgrounds will be needed to improve diversity of regional nursing workforce.
