How to Gain Institutional Access to the *All of Us* Dataset



Only researchers whose institutions have signed a **Data Use and Registration Agreement (DURA)** and who have verified their identity via **login.gov** may access the *All of Us* Researcher Workbench Registered and Controlled Tiers. Currently, any U.S.-based academic, nonprofit, or health care organization can enter into a DURA, which must be signed by an administrator with contracting authority.

The Data Use and Registration Agreement (DURA) Process



3 Categories of Agreements

- R** 1. Institutional agreements that grant all registered researchers access to the **Registered Tier only**, with no Controlled Tier access.
- R C** 2. Institutional agreements that grant all registered researchers access to **both the Registered and Controlled Tiers**. Some agreements may require additional approval for the Controlled Tier.
- i** 3. **Individual data-use agreements required** for any institutional researcher seeking access to the Registered or Controlled Tier.

Key: **R** Registered Tier **C** Controlled Tier **i** Individual agreements required by institution
