



At its meeting on January 18-20, 2022, the CCNE Board of Commissioners directed the following programs to “show cause” as to why adverse action should not be taken against the program. Importantly, the issuance of a show cause directive is not an adverse action, but a statement of serious concern by the Board. In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations, §602.26(b), CCNE is required to notify various entities, including the U.S. Department of Education, of this action.
