NURSES WITH BSN BY 2020

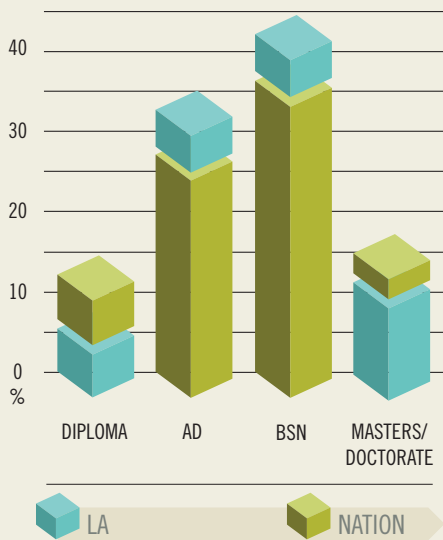

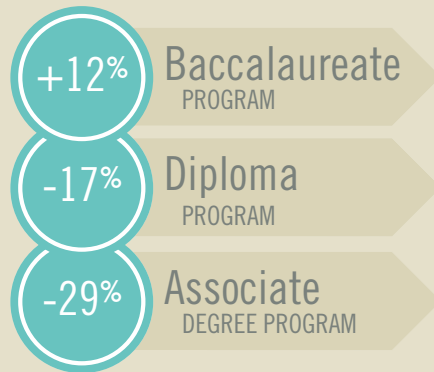
NURSES WITH DOCTORATE BY 2020



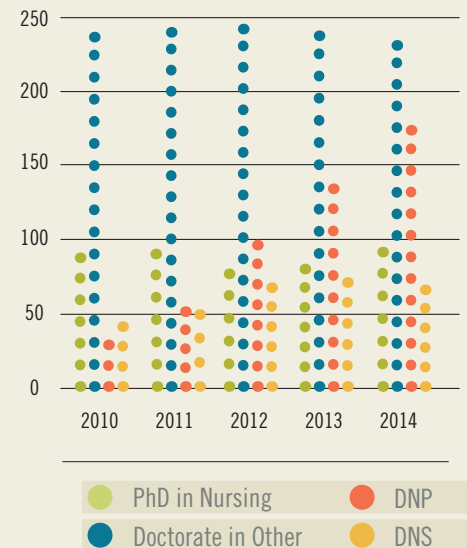
HIGHEST DEGREE HELD BY RNs RESIDING IN LA 2014



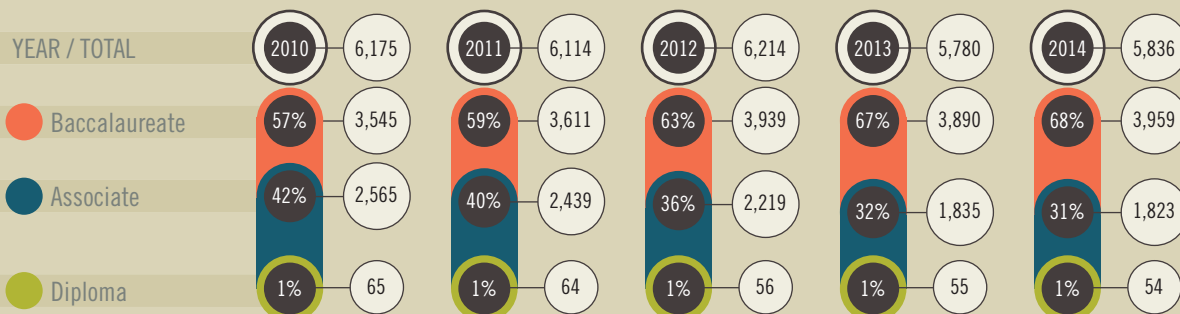
PRE-RN LICENSURE Program Enrollment Changes Since 2010



TYPES OF DOCTORATES HELD BY LICENSED RNs RESIDING IN LOUISIANA

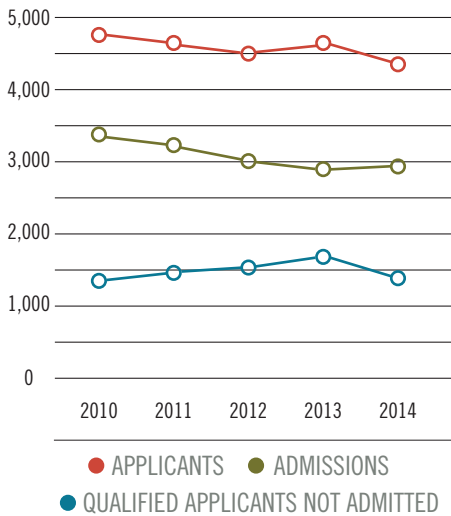


PRE-RN LICENSURE PROGRAMS ENROLLMENT IN LA (2010-2014)

136 (18%) faculty currently teaching in Louisiana's pre-RN licensure programs are 61+ years.

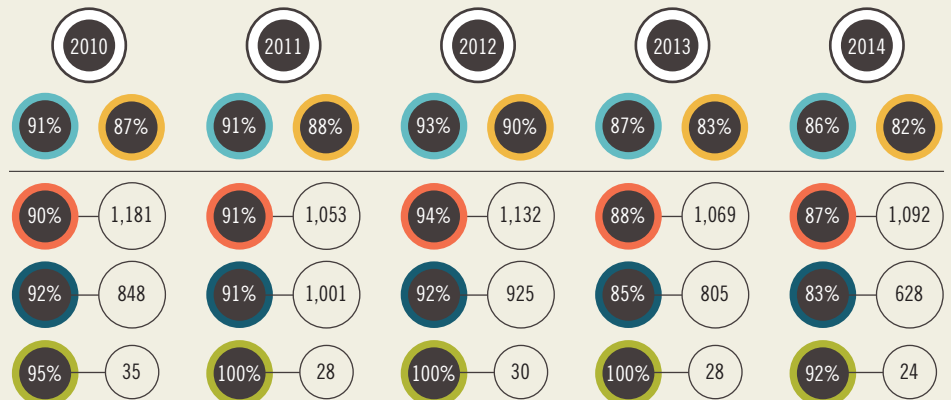


The passage rate on the NCLEX-RN for graduates from Louisiana's pre-RN licensure programs continues to exceed that of the nation in spite of the higher passing standard and the new test plan implemented in April 2013 by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing.

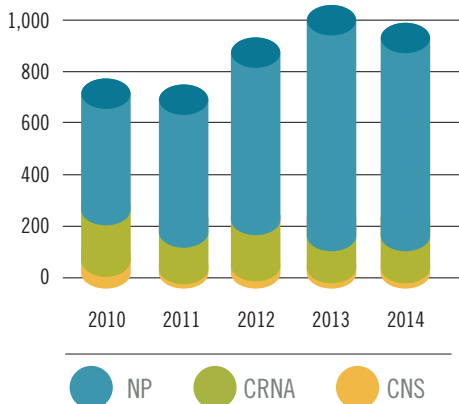

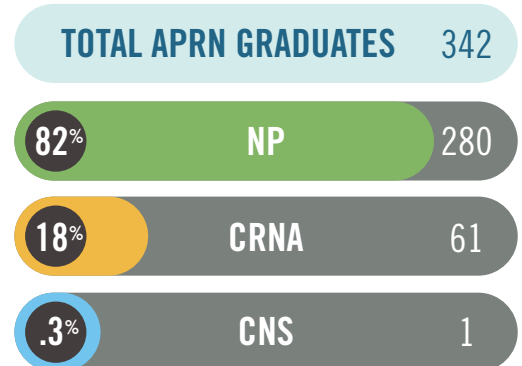


APRN EDUCATION CAPACITY

ENROLLMENT IN LA APRN PROGRAMS ACCORDING TO ROLE (2010-2014)

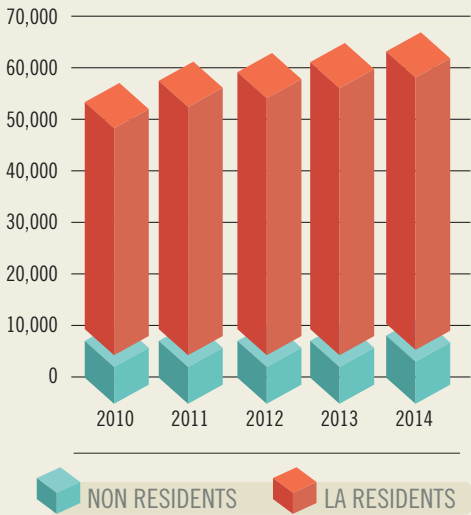


GRADUATES FROM APRN PROGRAMS IN LOUISIANA ACCORDING TO PROGRAM TYPE 2014

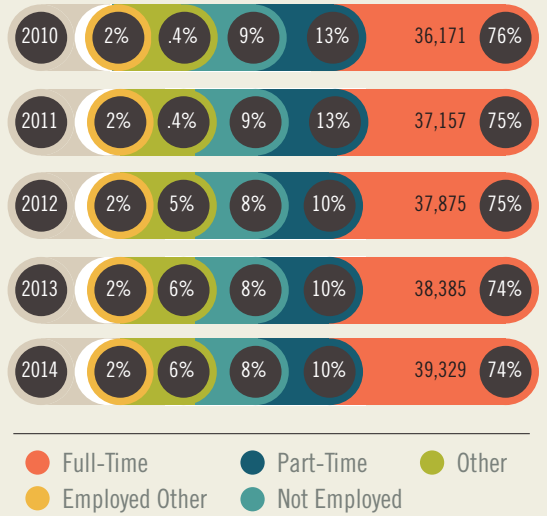

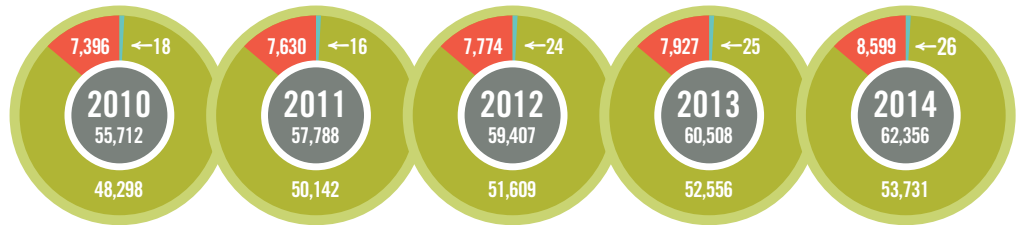
EMPLOYMENT DISTRIBUTION OF LICENSED REGISTERED NURSES RESIDING IN LA (2010-2014)



Over the past 5 years

- +12%** No. of RNs holding a license to practice nursing in LA
- +11%** No. of RNs licensed and residing in LA
- +16%** No. of Non Resident RNs that hold a license to practice in LA

86% (53,731) of nurses licensed to practice in Louisiana also lived in LA
14% (8,599) reported home addresses outside of Louisiana.



LICENSED REGISTERED NURSES RESIDING IN LA (2010-2014)

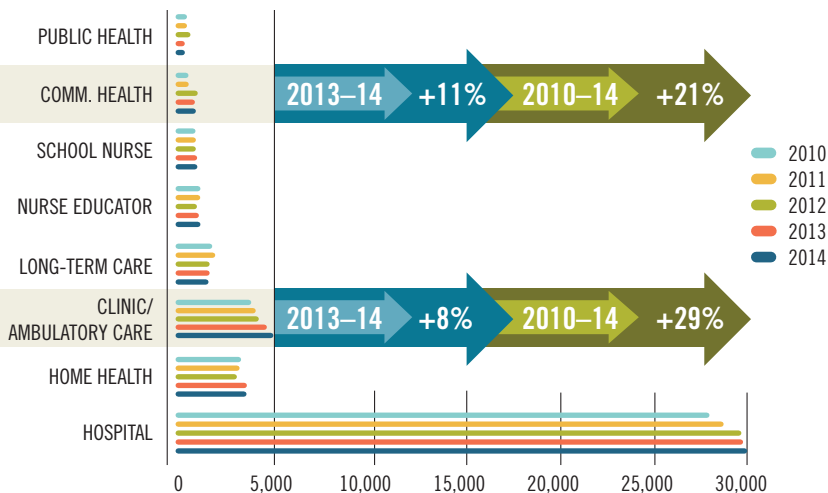

EMPLOYERS OF LICENSED REGISTERED NURSES RESIDING IN LA (2010-2014)

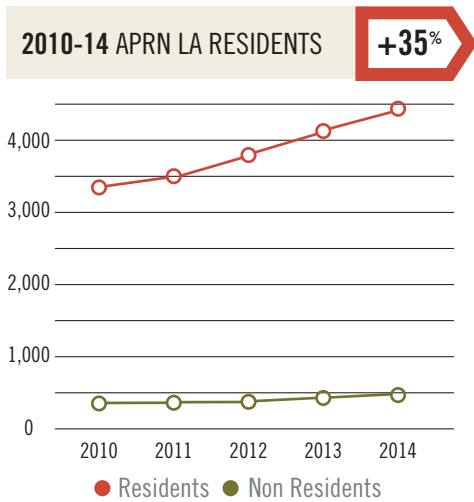


TYPES OF POSITIONS HELD BY LICENSED REGISTERED NURSES RESIDING IN LOUISIANA (2010-2014)

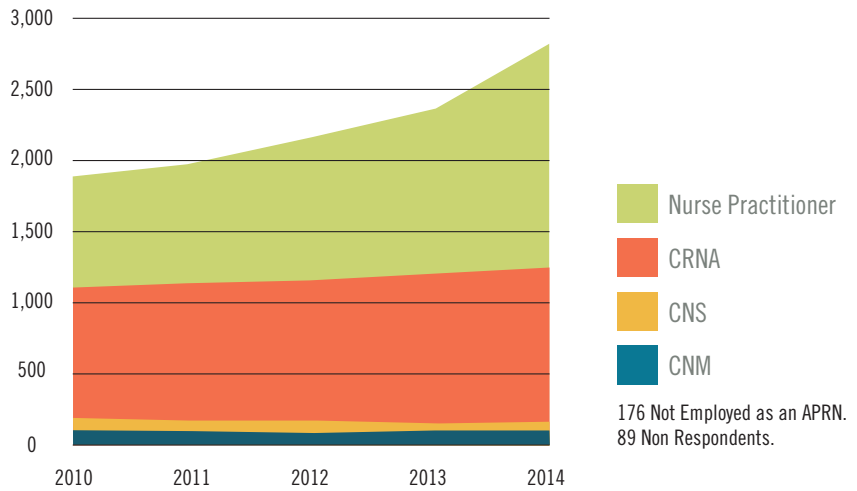
- 63%** **Staff Nurses** 33,547 of RNs licensed in Louisiana in 2014 were employed as staff nurses with 13% increase over the past 5 years.
- 10%** **Nurse Managers** 5,460 of the licensed RNs were nurse managers with 29% increase over the past 5 years.
- 5%** **Nurse Executives & Faculty** 2,594 of the licensed RNs were Nurse Executives and Faculty.
- 22%** **Other** 11,482 of the licensed RNs were APRNs, consultants, researchers, and other.
