

Specialty Rankings 2016

- Ranked in 2015
- The nursing specialty rankings are based solely on assessments by nursing school deans and deans of graduate studies who identified up to 10 schools offering the best programs in each specialty area.
- Those schools receiving the most votes in each specialty are numerically ranked in descending order based on the number of nominations they received, as long as they received seven or more nominations in that specialty area.

USNWR says that:

"the upcoming master's ranking methodology will change since we have changed the definitions of many of the statistical indicators used in last year's ranking (2016) per our work with AACN and other deans at nursing schools. We will rank DNP programs using a separate methodology than the master's ranking uses."

- Also Nurse Midwifery and Nurse Anesthesia rankings will be done based on the universe of all accredited programs.
