Chartering the Seas for the Most Effective Post-Graduation Student Success

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PURPOSE

 Increase student success in relationship to first-time pass rates for the National Council Licensing Examination – Registered Nurse (NCLEX-RN).



BACKGROUND

- Noted a decline in NCLEX-RN first-time pass rates in both traditional and baccalaureate nursing completion programs
 - Need to meet benchmark to maintain accreditation
 - Warning from Accreditor
- Decreased faculty and student morale
- Change in integrated testing vendors
- Creation of N490, Licensure Preparation Course, within the curriculum.
- Support from department chairperson and upper administration.





- Empower and enable students to be successful on the first attempt on the NCLEX-RN
- Combination Approach:
 - Pilot group
 - Established a written pre/post-graduation plan
 - Assigned a post-graduation coach
 - Incorporate one or more testing platforms postgraduation



WRITTEN PLAN

- Students developed a first/mid/final- action plan that would help with the following:
 - Time-management
 - Incorporate all aspects of student's life into the calendar
 - Develop a study routine prior to graduation
 - Allows them to see what is working and what is not working

Make changes as needed prior to graduation

 Develops an accountability relationship with N 490 faculty that will carry onto post-graduation coach



ADDITIONAL TESTING PLATFORM

• Obtained an internal university funded grant

- Finance a small amount of additional computerized bank of questions
- Grant allowed for 19 students
- Post predictor exam
 - Identified those students whom were at highest risk for being unsuccessful on their first NCLEX-RN attempt
 - Lottery was held for both programs
 - 14 traditional baccalaureate program
 - 5 baccalaureate completion program (BNC)



NOTIFICATION OF ADDITIONAL TESTING PLATFORM

Notified students via email:
additional question banks available postgraduation free of charge.
account information sent through the computerized question bank.
90 day subscription with over 2000 questions, and 2 readiness exams.



TESTING PLATFORM RESULTS

- Traditional Cohort
 - Average
 - # of Questions utilized: 1192
 - # total time spent: 19:38 hours/minutes
 - # Passed on first attempt: 12 out of 14 (86%)
- BNC Cohort
 - Average
 - # of Questions utilized: 990
 - # total time spent: 14:08 hours/minutes
 - # Passed on first attempt: 4 out of 5 (80%)



LIMITATIONS

- Pool too small
 - 19 students total
- Additional testing platform products could show different results
- Variables
 - Age
 - Different skill sets
 - For example = LPN may have developed poor study skills
 - Data
 - Did we sell it appropriately?
 - Free product proven to be successful for many
