Dr. Mandy Kirkpatrick is a Professor of Nursing at Creighton University College of Nursing (CUCON). Dr. Kirkpatrick has received national recognition for excellence in teaching, innovation, and research in the areas of interprofessional education, simulation, and palliative care (PC). Mandy's career has been focused on promoting interprofessional and PC competence development among students and clinicians through in-person and distance simulation. Her published concept analysis of palliative care nursing presents a visual model for promoting primary PC competence development, establishing a foundation for tool development and competence assessment. She has been sought out for her expertise in distance-based

simulation methods and for promoting PC and IPE through simulation nationally and internationally. Her current projects include a qualitative study of advance care planning barriers and facilitators among students, faculty, and aging Nebraskans.
