Walker & Avant Model

Eight Steps of Walker & Avant's Method

- Choose a concept
- Determine the purpose of the analysis
- Exhaustively define the uses of the concept- use multiple sources
- Identify attributes
- Identify antecedents and consequences

- Develop a model case
- Develop borderline/contrary cases
- Identify empirical referents

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Why Socratic Questioning ???


- Encourage critical thinking....
- Explore complex ideas....
- Separate what we know from what we do not know....




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• Clarify Concepts...... • "Is this what you are saying?" • Probe for Assumptions... • "Who might refute your argument?"



Coetzee & Laschingerit Compassion Fatigue Model • According to Coetzee & Laschingerit, (2018), "it is not empathy that puts nurses at risk of developing compassion fatigue, but rather a lack of resources, inadequate positive feedback, and the nurse's response to personal distress" (p. 4). Empathy - being aware of and sharing another person's feelings, experiences, and emotions.
