
Impacting Indigenous Nursing Student Success by Embracing & Implementing Indigenous Values to Provide Holistic Support



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Increasing Indigeneous Nursing Students

- Bemidji State University (Minnesota, USA) received a HRSA Nursing Workforce Diversity grant in 2017
- \$2 million, 4-year project to recruit, retain, graduate, and license baccalaureate-prepared indigenous nurses
- Niganawenimaanaanig (Ojibwe word meaning "we take care of them") established




Key Components of Niganawenimaanaanig

- Financial Support








Retention and Attrition

- 100% freshmen retention
- 92% retention rate overall with all students enrolled in Niganawenimaanaanig
