<p>Academic Progression in Nursing-Strengthening Academic Ties</p> <p>Tammy Colatruglio, RN, MSN, Director of Nursing, Department of Nursing, Nursing Education Center, John Tyler Community College</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dorrie introduced Tammy Colatruglio and Kathy Haugh to report on their work on academic progression. • Last summer schools with RN-BSN programs and VCCS representatives met to discuss academic progression. • Tammy gave an update on the VCCS common curriculum. 4 schools go live fall 2017 with all being mandated to begin the new curriculum by fall 2018. Microbiology is new to the curriculum and health assessment is now a stand-alone course. Patho and Pharm are embedded courses. • 4 year institutions are developing a grid with all prerequisites courses. • The group is investigating how this affects guaranteed admissions agreements. • VA is listed as one of the best performing states in the RN-BSN progression. • There was further general discussion about academic progression: AACN Academic progression task force will be evaluating models for academic progression (among other tasks). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members of VACN will continue to work with this group.
